The hotel has set aside a block of rooms at the above rates. Please make reservations as early in advance as possible. Every attempt will be made to accommodate room requests prior to the cutoff date. (The hotel will make these rates available for the weekends before and after the event as well). After the cutoff date, rooms are on a space available basis, i.e. it will be extremely difficult to secure a room at this location for less than the going rate of \$185 and up per night!

The Hyatt is located in the Palm Springs Village area within walking distance of many shops, reasonably priced restaurants, and casino gaming establishments. Palm Springs is a Mecca for golf. Those of you who are so inclined will find special rates available at the Rancho Mirage Country Club. Inquire about tee times and rates at the front desk.

The area is well served by jet service from most major airlines to the Palm Springs airport. Reno and Alaska Air are popular west coast carriers who provide a number of flights into the area as well. There are direct jet flights from Denver and Chicago, as well as other major cities.

The hotel provides a complimentary on demand shuttle service from the Palm Springs airport. To drive from the airport (approx. 3-4 miles). exit the car rental lot by turning left onto El Cielo Road. At the first stop sign make a right onto Tahquitz Canyon Road. Proceed approximately 2 miles making a right onto Indian Avenue. Indian Avenue is a four lane one way road. You'll need to get over to the left and make a left at Amado followed by another left onto North Palm Canyon Drive. The hotel is directly on the right as you turn onto North Palm Canyon. The underground parking garage entrance is adjacent to the front entrance to the hotel.

Alternatively, Ontario airport is about 90 miles from the Palm Springs area. For those of you who are adventurous in spirit, pick up I-10 East from the airport to State highway 111. The desert drive is quite scenic, consisting of the skeletal remains of others who were stupid enough to make this drive. Remain on 111 for approximately 11 miles where it becomes North Palm Canyon Drive. Continue on through town to Amado, where you'll see the Hyatt on the right just past the intersection.

From Orange County pick up State Highway 91 to State Highway 60 until it merges with I-10. Then follow the directions above.
