Routing Directions:

Starting at the San Jose Airport (SJC), CA

Exit Brokaw Road (Main entrance)

Turn right on to Guadalupe Parkway

Take Guadalupe Parkway South, it turns into 87 which then merges with 85 South which then merges with 101 South.

Exit 101 South at State Road 156 West (approximately 60 miles from SJC).

Continue on State Road 156 until it merges with State Road 1 (Cabrillo Hwy).

Exit at 218 Del Rey Oaks. Turn left under the freeway.

The Embassy Suites is the large 12 story building on your right.

If you are coming from San Francisco Airport (SFO) take 101 South to State Road 156 (approximately 100 miles from SFO).

The adventuresome can take Highway 17 South, and pick up State Road 1 for a scenic drive from SJC. If you coming out of SFO and want to spend a day or two driving, take 380 to 280 North headed into San Francisco, then take pick up State Road 1 off the connector and come down through Pacifica, Half Moon Bay, Santa Cruz, etc. Most challenging if driven late at night, with a new moon, heavy fog, and a fast sports car – gets the adrenaline pumping.
