Dear Mr. Rutherford,

Thank you for your public review comment on NCITS BSR 333, Multimedia Commands - 2 (MMC-2), contained in T10/99-307r0 at <ftp://ftp.t10.org/t10/document.99/99-307r0.pdf>. The T10 Technical Committee elected to not make any changes to the MMC-2 draft standard and responded to your comment as follows:

" The sub-header is 8 bytes. It is actually a 4 byte field which is simply repeated. The form is one bit in within 4 bytes. The presumption is you only want to send 2048 (instead of 2056) bytes per sector or 2328 (instead of 2336) bytes per sector. If specification of form is provided together with those block sizes, there is no way to specify the other 31 bits of the sub-header?"
