Driving directions from Seattle / Tacoma airport:

Follow the signs at the airport to 405 North then take 520 East. A new exit just opened for NE 40<sup>th</sup> Street; make a right at the light onto NE 40<sup>th</sup> Street and a right at the next light onto 156<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE. Building 42 is on the right side just before the second traffic light. If you miss the entrance to the underground parking lot on 156<sup>th</sup>, make a right at the light onto NE 31<sup>st</sup> Street and take the next entrance on the right. After you find a way up from the parking lot, proceed to the Building 42 lobby. If you park in a "Visitor" space, make sure you tell the receptionist.

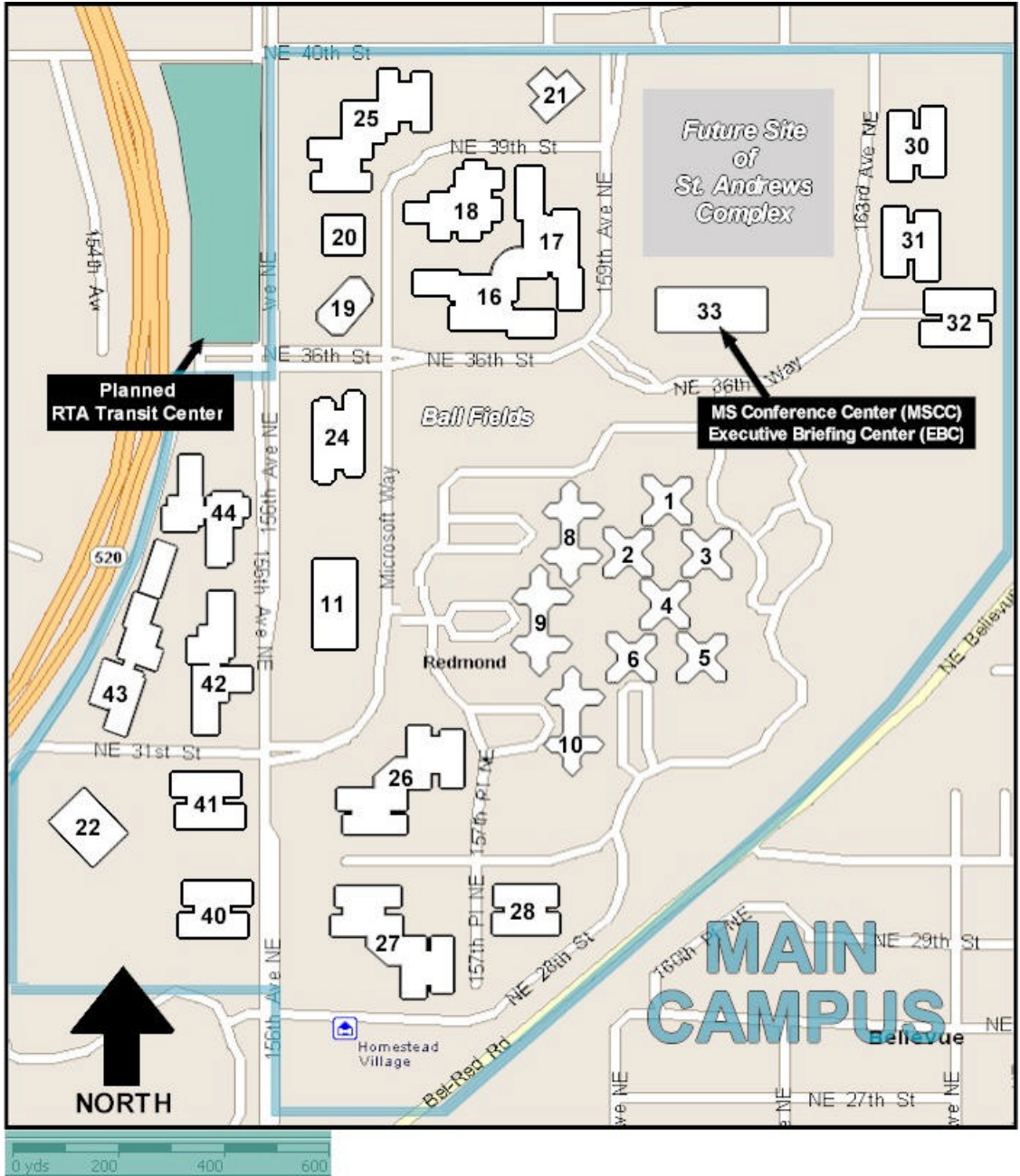
