Statement of Intel Corporation ("Intel") regarding compliance with ANSI/NCITS/T10 patent policy:

Intel will submit a letter of assurance stating whether it is willing to negotiate licenses on a "non-discriminatory basis on reasonable terms and conditions." Intel does not perform patent searches in order to determine which of its patents may read on a standard. However, Intel endeavors to state the terms and conditions under which it will license to third parties its patents that read on the standard within 4 weeks following approval of the standard and, in any event, prior to any vote for final approval of the standard.
