Subject: Proposed change to Table 9 in SSC-2, revision 2

## Overview

Table 9 in SSC-2 revision 2 describes which commands are allowed and which should return Reservation Conflict in the presence of various types of reservations. The columns labeled "Write Exclusive" and "Write Exclusive RO" are filled with N/A. The N/A presumably indicates not applicable, although this is not defined in the specification.

Barring convincing arguments to the contrary, Quantum would like to define values for these columns. This proposal includes recommendations for each entry. Additionally, we recommend extending the table to include the new commands that have been added to SSC-2.

## Add text or a note near the table:

Due to the nature of streaming type devices, Write Exclusive and Write Exclusive, Registrants Only modes of reservation do not protect an initiator's continuity of operations when using the Implicit Command set. While these modes do protect unauthorized modification of the data, they do not protect from medium position changes that could result in errors due to incorrect position. It is the responsibility of the initiators to manage this using means beyond the scope of this specification. Initiators should use exclusive modes of reservation while actively accessing the medium to prevent interference from other initiators.
