Scope: This standard specifies functional requirements for SCSI-3 Stream Commands (SSC).SSC permits SCSI streaming devices such as tape and printer devices to attach to computers and provides the definitions for their use. This standard does not contain material related to any service delivery subsystem which is used to transport the commands, command parameter data, command response data, and status specified in this Standard.

Purpose and justification: SSC provides the stream command definitions that are needed for the companion SCSI standards.
