T11 Liaison Report

• TC T11 last met Dec. 12, 2002.

65 representatives of 53 organizations attended. The total number of member organizations is 60.

Special INCITS awards were presented to John Lohmeyer, Kumar Malavali, George Penokie, Ralph Weber, and Steve Wilson.

Liaison is maintained with INCITS, T10, SNIA, and FCIA.

T11 requested ISO new work items for FC-AV, FC-PI, and FC-FS, and voted to approve FCD 14165-222, (FC-SB-2).

T11 took all the requested actions of its TGs as described below.

• TG T11.2 - FC physical layer TG:

Membership is 41 companies.

Liaison is maintained with T11, SFF, T10, PICMG, and FCIA.

Multiple single-mode long distance optical PMDs are being proposed. Bi-directional optical PMDs are being proposed. No project is assigned for these activities yet.

4 Gb/s copper interface parameters are being adjusted in FC-PI-2.

Projects in development include FC-MJSQ and FC-PI-2.

FC-SM is to be forwarded.

10GFC is in second public review.

FC-PI is now published.

 T11.3 - FC logical / protocol TG Membership is 49 companies. Liaison is maintained with T11, T10, T11.3, IETF, FCIA, and T1X1.

Projects in or entering the approval stage include: FC-BB-2, FC-FS, and FC-SB-3.

Projects in development include: FC-AE-2, FC-DA, FC-GS-4, FC-MI-2, FC-SP, and FC-SW-3.

New projects being proposed include T1X1 GFP mapping, FC over IPv6, and FC-FS-2.

• T11.5, storage network management TG

Membership is 44 companies.

Liaison is maintained with T11, DMTF, IETF, and SNIA.

Proposals for the SM-MM and SM-AMD were forwarded.

The FC-HBA & FC-SWAPI projects are in development.

The MIB-FA was forwarded for final approval.
