February, 2003

TC T11 last met Feb. 6, 2003.

60 representatives of 52 organizations attended. The total number of member organizations is 58.

T11 deferred the requested ISO actions for letter ballot action.

T11 took all the requested actions of its TGs as described below.

TG T11.2 - FC physical layer TG:

Membership is 40 companies.

Multiple single-mode long distance optical PMDs are being proposed. Bi-directional optical PMDs are being proposed. FC-PI-3 will be the recipient for some of these.

Projects in development include FC-MJSQ and FC-PI-2.

FCSM forwarding was corrected.

10GFC is forwarded for third public review.

A total of 9 teleconferences were authorized to continue development on FC-PI-2, FC-MJSQ, GFP-T, and new optical variants.

T11.3 - FC logical / protocol TG

Membership is 50 companies.

FC-BB-2 was forwarded to INCITS.

Projects in the approval stage include: FC-FS, FC-GS-4, FC-SB-3, FC-DA, and FC-SW-3.

Projects in the development phase include: FC-AE-2, FC-MI-2, and FC-SP.

IPv6 over FC Study Group was formed.

T1X1 GFP proposals are being reviewed and a liaison submittal is being prepared.

Project proposals include: FC-FS-2 and FC-LS.

T11.5, storage network management TG
Membership is 34 companies.

The MIB-FA and FC-SWAPI projects are in approval.

The FC-HBA, SM-MM, and SM-AMD projects are in development.

SNIA principles of cooperation were drafted.
