Rod Wideman read the original e-mail to the group. Susan Gray stated that she scanned ADT and found text that stated what to do upon reception of a Link Services IU with a Frame Number not equal to zero.

Michael's original e-mail suggested using NAK Status code equal to 43h, Invalid or Illegal IU Received. Rod and Matthew Bondurant suggested adding a new NAK Status code. In the end the group agreed to use the existing code 43h.

Michael Banther will bring in a proposal against ADT mandating response with NAK Status code of 43h upon reception of a non-link services IU with Frame Number equal to zero.
