## 2.0.1 Extended INQUIRY Data VPD page

The Extended INQUIRY Data VPD page (see table 1) provides the application client with a means to obtain information about the logical unit.

A group function supported (GROUP SUP) bit set to one shall indicate that group function (see SBC-2) is supported by the device server. A GROUP SUP bit set to zero shall indicate that group function is not supported.
