Hi Ralph,

In **7.4.8 Disconnect-Reconnect mode page**

4th Paragraph

“If a parameter that is not appropriate for the specific SCSI transport protocol implemented by the target port is non-zero, the command shall be terminated with CHECK CONDITION status, with the sense key set to ILLEGAL REQUEST, and the additional sense code set to ILLEGAL FIELD IN PARAMETER LIST.”

ILLEGAL FIELD IN PARAMETER LIST does not have an ASC/ASCQ assigned. I assume this is supposed to be INVALID FIELD IN PARAMETER LIST. I have it as a letter ballot comment in SAS-1.1 for the Disconnect-Reconnect mode page, as I'm sure it was copied over from SPC-3.
