7. Discussion items:

7.1 SMC-3 Open/Close Import/Export Element (05-070r1) [Snelder]

Discussion revolved around the difference of Lock/Unlock; PAMR; and Open/Close.

Veritas states that when import/export element has been accessed is issued the results are not standard so they repeatedly issue Move MEDIUM until it passes. That is, what does closed mean? UA behaviour for scan complete (new UA) should be in model section not in this command.

Noud Snelder made a motion for incorporation of 05-070r0 as revised into SMC-3.

Michael Banther seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

7.2 SMC-3 Extended device capabilities (05-078r0) [Snelder]

All these properties were copied from the Microsoft TDK. Greg said he doesn't know of any ISV's that use a Microsoft Media Changer driver. The group reviewed this proposal with many suggestions for modifications and gave Noud direction on how to make changes to be standard's consistent. Greg, "We hate autoclean".
