Rod Wideman discussed the changes made from 05-243r2, and noted that a motion to approve 05-243r2 had been tabled at the previous meeting. Curtis Ballard noted that r3 did not define page code 0 as mandatory, and said that he had requested this be added via e-mail. Rod therefore edited r3 in the meeting to define that page code 0 be mandatory where the device server supports the EVPD bit being set to one. The tabled motion was then modified to reference 05-243r4 (r3 as modified at this meeting), and the motion passed unanimously. Action items were assigned to Rod Wideman to post 05-243r4, and to Noud Snelder to incorporate 05-243r4 in the next revision of SMC.

7.5 SMC-3 Clarification SEND VOLUME TAG command (05-414r2)

Noud Snelder

Noud Snelder discussed the changes made from 05-414r1. There was a long discussion about the Volume Sequence Number field and is use to disambiguate volumes with identical barcodes or Volume Identifiers. It was noted that the use of the Volume Sequence Number field had never been clearly defined even though the field has existed since SCSI-2. Many other changes were made during the meeting, and Noud accepted an Action Item to post a new revision of 05-414r2.

7.6 SMC-3 Report Supported Medium Types (06-046r3)

Curtis Ballard discussed the changes from 06-046r3. There was a spirited discussion about the definition of form factor, and modifications were made. The format of the Volume Type Descriptor was discussed in detail, and a decision taken to have only a single description field in each descriptor. Curtis accepted an Action Item to post a new revision of 06-046r3.
