TC T11 last met June 15, 2006.

49 representatives of 42 organizations attended. The total number of member organizations is 52.

New projects FC-SP-2 and FC-GS-6 were announced.

FC-AE-RDMA and FC-AL-2 Amendment 2 were published.

The INCITS OID of {iso(1) member-body(2) us(840) INCITS(114402)} was announced for T11 and may be used by other TCs.

T11 took all the requested actions of its TGs as described below.

Membership is 39 organizations.
