
# Footnotes

must be numbered consecutively throughout the document. (Notes are numbered consecutively within a clause or subclause only.



### Multiplication sign

Instead of \* use × throughout the document.



Replace "self test" by "self-test" throughout the document.

# Numbering convention for lists

First lower case letters, then Arabic numerals, then Roman numerals, etc. Also, within the same clause/subclause the numbering should be consecutive, i.e. two references "a)", etc. should be avoided (e.g. see subclause 5.6.9). a) Text

- lext
- 1) list
- 2) list
  - i) x ii) ...
- b) text



Since a different order is used in this document, it should be added in the conventions for lists within lists

- a) Text
  - A) list, etc.

(see 5.2.2 and other occurrences of lists within lists).



#### **Basic layout**

Please see the attached WORD document "Normative references".

Top should be 3 cm (running heading on 2 cm without indentation), left and right margin should be 2,5 cm (this applies also to the list of contents – there should be no indentation for the page numbers).

# Main title

Please present as shown in attached WORD document "Normative references".



#### 2 Normative references

The normative references should be one clause (not several subclauses), see attached document. All the references must be publicly available. After discussions with the central office we stay with two subclauses: one for references to ISO, IEC and ITU documents and the other one for other normative references. Please make sure that all the references cited in the document are either indicated in the list of normative references or in a bibliography.


All the web pages, e.g. as indicated in several Annexes, must also be repeated in a

Particularly tables 87, 262, 283, D.14 and D.15 contain a lot of references to documents. Not all of them are cited.




