Subject: Aborting the untagged task

Background:

SCSI-3 now allows a task set to contain tagged as well untagged tasks. In SIP, however, there is currently no way to abort just the untagged task. An ABORT command issued to the I_T_L nexus performs an ABORT TASK SET and an ABORT TASK issued to an I_T_L nexus is now illegal.

Proposal:

Modify SIP to specify that an ABORT TASK message always aborts the current nexus (provided it is an I_T_L or I_T_L_Q nexus).
