

Comments from Robert Elliott E-Mail on EDD-3

April 16, 2004

1. In Table 14 Device Path Definitions, since EDD previously had separate entries for ATA and ATAPI, it seems like there should be separate entries for SATA and ATAPI over SATA (perhaps called "SATAPI").
2. The SATA device path needs a port multiplier port field to identify separate devices behind a with port multiplier. So will the SATAPI device path.
3. There should be separate SAS-SATA and SAS-SATAPI device paths, distinct from the plain SAS device path. They both need SAS address and port multiplier port fields (a port multiplier could be attached to a SAS expander).
4. The FIBRE device path needs to clarify the endianness of the Port Name. The SAS device paths need to clarify the endianness of the SAS address field.
5. An iSCSI device path should be defined.
