In X3T9.2/88-146 it was proposed that information concerning the DDS structure of Digital Audio Tape ^(DAT) be added to Section 9.

I would like to propose that a new peripheral Device Type be added to SCSI-3.

There are many features possible using DAT that do not fit within the Sequential Access device Model. Audio Commands are just one example.

This will also Allow the various groups working to define how DAT is used for DATA storage a chance to Flesh out their designs and for a standard to Emerge
