Ms. Barra,

Thank you for your considerations in the area of scanner devices in regards to SCSI-2. We have based our SCSI interface as well we can around the existing SCSI-2 scanner specification, using appropriate vendor-unique extensions where needed (this being in accord with your response suggestion). To date we have had no problems with our own people nor with customers in connection with the implementation of the SCSI interface on our scanners.

However, I would like to re-emphasize that there remain items specific to film media scanning that must be considered. These include scanner type (microfiche and roll film scanners as well as the aperture card scanners), full media scan processes that cannot be paused or stepped once started, tiling considerations, etc.

I will be contacting J. Lohmeyer in regards to participation in SCSI-3.
