Due to mutual interests in PC memory interface standards PCMCIA requests the opportunity to make a brief PC Card Technical Presentation on the subject Standard (Release 1.0, issued November 1990) at the forthcoming X3T9.2 plenary meeting February 18-19, in Austin, TX. The standard details design guidelines for mechanical, electrical interface, host interface protocol, and data format for a parallel type IC card assembly.
