Subject: Interpretation of Section 6.5.2 of SCSI-2

Section 6.5.2 of the SCSI-2 specification discusses the appropriate target response to an incorrect initiator connection. It states that all of the initiator's I/O processes are to be aborted and a Check Condition returned.

It seems clear that a Check Condition should be returned for the current incorrect connection. The question is regarding the aborted I/O processes: do they generate Check Conditions also, or are they discarded with no status generated for them, assuming that the initial bad connection's Check Condition suffices to warrant their demise with no status?
