X3 Technical Committee Annual Report for 1991 X3T9.2 -- Lower Level Interfaces

I. Projects

1. **Small Computer System Interface (SCSI-2)**
 - a. Project 375-R, Small Computer System Interface (SCSI-2)
 - b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

Original target date:	January 1988
Previous target date:	September 1991
Current target date:	December 1991
 - c. Project Description: This is an extension of ANSI, X3.131, Small Computer System Interface, a low cost but highly "intelligent" bus interface for microprocessor-based computer systems. The interface is primarily aimed at the interconnection of small computers and high-bandwidth block transfer peripherals and includes relatively high-level command sets for magnetic disks and tapes, optical disks, and printers. This is a multimaster bus which also supports direct computer-to-computer interconnections. SCSI-2 adds some new device types (e.g., scanners, communications devices, and "jukeboxes") and considerably expands the command sets for some existing device types. It also provides for faster data transfer rates (up to 40 MBytes per second).
 - d. Publications During Past Year: Revisions 10d, 10e, 10f, 10g, and 10h of X3T9.2/86-109, Small Computer System Interface - 2, were issued during 1991. Revision 10h was forwarded by X3T9 at its December 1991 meeting for public review.
 - e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: In late 1990, X3T9.2 requested that X3T9 take the necessary steps to recall SCSI-2 from ANSI (which had approved revision 10c in August 1990). This recall was to correct a number of minor problems encountered during the ANSI publication process. During 1991 SCSI-2 was converted from WordStar (tm) to Word Perfect (tm) so that the document could be reviewed by the task group in a form closer to final publication format. Furthermore, a number of ambiguities and misleading statements were clarified and corrected.
 - f. Statement of Status as of This Report: SCSI-2 revision 10h has been forwarded to X3 for a second public review period. It is the Task Group's understanding that the document will be processed at Milestone 8 as if technical changes were made as the result of the first public review.
 - g. Future Plans: X3T9.2 has begun activities on several approved projects that are often referred to collectively as SCSI-3. These projects are: SCSI-3 Parallel Interface (SPI) [855-D], SCSI-3 Interlocked Protocol (SIP) [856-D], SCSI-3 Packetized Protocol (SPP) [881-D], and SCSI-3 Command Set (SCS) [854-D].

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- h. Reasons for Delay: The project was delayed because of a change in the ANSI publication practices which was made retroactive to include SCSI-2.

2. Enhanced Small Device Interface (ESDI)

- a. Project 587-D, Enhanced Small Device Interface (ESDI)
- b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

- c. Project Description: ESDI defines a disk interface oriented toward newer disk drives with transfer rates of 10 to 24 Mbit/sec. Much of the development work on ESDI was done by an industry group while this project was assigned to X3T9.3. In June 1987, this project was transferred to X3T9.2.
- d. Publications During Past Year: ANSI X3.170-1991 and X3.170A-1991.
- e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: The standard and the amendment to delete Table 28 were concurrently published the last week of December 1991.
- f. Statement of Status as of This Report: Published.
- g. Future Plans: X3T9.2 has no current plans to revise or enhance ESDI. This interface is obsolete in that few (if any) new products are being designed to it. The standards process has been so slow on this project that the ANSI standard is now mostly of historical interest.
- h. Reasons for Delay: ANSI was unwilling to accept the unanimous consensus of X3, X3T9, and X3T9.2 that the deletion of Table 28 was purely editorial.

3. Small Computer System Interface (SCSI-3)

- a. Project 685-D, Small Computer System Interface (SCSI-3)
- b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

- c. Project Description: This project, which would have included all of the SCSI-3 work in one document, has been superseded by four projects: SCSI-3 Parallel Interface (SPI) [855-D], SCSI-3 Interlocked Protocol (SIP) [856-D], SCSI-3 Packetized Protocol (SPP) [881-D], and SCSI-3 Command Set (SCS) [854-D].

4. SCSI Common Access Method (SCSI CAM)

- a. Project 792-D, SCSI Common Access Method
- b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

Original target date: August 1991

- c. Project Description: This project will define a common method to access SCSI devices through a standard software interface to SCSI host adapters for several popular operating systems. This should result in simplified integration of products.
- d. Publications During Past Year: Three revisions of the SCSI-2 Common Access Method Transport and SCSI Interface Module working draft document was distributed.
- e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: Revision 2.5 of the document was forwarded to X3T9 and passed the X3T9 letter ballot on forwarding the document to X3 for its first public review period. However, X3T9 agreed to return the document to X3T9.2 to address a comment that accompanied a "yes" ballot and to address additional comments received directly by X3T9.2 after it had forwarded SCSI CAM.
- f. Statement of Status as of This Report: X3T9.2 expects to distribute another revision of SCSI CAM in its March 1992 mailing for possible forwarding at its April 1992 meeting.
- g. Future Plans: X3T9.2 expects to forward CAM back to X3T9 in April 1992.
- h. Reasons for Delay: X3T9.2 decided that SCSI CAM would benefit from addressing the comments received after its initial forwarding.

5. AT Attachment Interface for Disk Drives (ATA)

- a. Project 791-D, AT Attachment Interface for Disk Drives
- b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

- c. Project Description: The widespread use of desktop computers with a 16-bit memory bus has led to the adoption within the industry of a disk drive which attaches via a subset of the personal computer AT bus. Because of their compatibility with existing personal computer AT hardware and software this interface quickly became a de facto industry standard. The intent of this project is to develop a standard to specify a subset of the AT bus specifically for the direct attachment of peripherals. This standard will specify the mechanical and electrical characteristics as well as the methods by which commands are directed to peripherals, the contents of registers, and the method of data transfers.
- d. Publications During Past Year: Four revisions of the AT Attachment working draft standard were distributed.
- e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: The draft proposed AT Attachment standard has been forwarded to X3 for its first public review period.
- f. Statement of Status as of This Report: AT Attachment is at SPARC waiting for its compliance review before beginning its first public review period.
- g. Future Plans: A project proposal for an ATA Extensions project has been submitted to SPARC. If approved, this project will result in a standard that adds several features to AT Attachment including the ability to attach more than two devices; and mapping the interface to the emerging Memory Card interface.
- h. Reasons for Delay: What's four months among friends?

6. SCSI-3 Command Set (SCS)

a. Project 854-D, SCSI-3 Command Set

b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

c. Project Description: The SCSI-3 Command Set standard will maintain a high degree of compatibility with SCSI-2 command sets while providing extensions and enhancements to support new features and new devices. This standard will not include the physical transport and media access layers as was the case in SCSI-2. Instead, multiple transport mechanisms will be supported through separate standards.

d. Publications During Past Year: none.

e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: Some agreements have been reached and are documented in the form of accepted proposals and/or meeting minutes.

f. Statement of Status as of This Report: The Task Group still does not have a volunteer for editor of this document. If an editor is not found soon, the project will not meet the target date.

g. Future Plans: It seems likely that the SCSI-3 Command Set will be structured into three or more parts, each part containing related command sets. One suggested division is Block, Stream, and Other command sets. It may be advisable to break this project into three separate projects along this division. This would break a large document into more manageable documents and may facilitate finding editors. (Of course, three editors would then be necessary.)

h. Reasons for Delay: No delay, yet.

7. SCSI-3 Parallel Interface (SPI)

a. Project 855-D, SCSI-3 Parallel Interface

b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

Original target date: April 1992

c. Project Description: The SCSI-3 Parallel Interface standard will maintain a high degree of compatibility with SCSI-2 while providing documentation for new capabilities including an option to permit 16-bit data transfers on a single cable and expanded bus connectivity options to increase the maximum number of SCSI devices on a cable from 8 to 16 or more. This standard is not intended to address areas above the physical level (such as protocol and command sets). It is intended that this proposed standard could be used in conjunction with the command sets defined in SCSI-2 and/or subsequent versions of SCSI.

d. Publications During Past Year: Two draft documents were distributed.

e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: The document architecture and draft versions of the draft standard were distributed. Significant effort has been focused on solving the signal quality issues on single-ended SCSI.

- f. Statement of Status as of This Report: A SPI ad hoc group has been established to address the remaining physical issues. Delays on the other SCSI-3 projects may result in X3T9.2 choosing to delay the forwarding of this project.
- g. Future Plans: none.
- h. Reasons for Delay: Reaching consensus on signal quality issues is taking longer than expected. Delays in the other SCSI-3 projects may cause further delays in this project.

8. SCSI-3 Interlocked Protocol (SIP)

- a. Project 856-D, SCSI-3 Interlocked Protocol

- b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

- c. Project Description: The SCSI-3 Interlocked Protocol standard will maintain a high degree of compatibility with the equivalent functions in SCSI-2 while defining several new features and functions. The candidate new features are support of more than 8 devices, dual porting, and other evolutionary features. This standard is intended to be used in conjunction with the SCSI-2 Parallel Interface standard and the SCSI-3 Command Set standard.

- d. Publications During Past Year: A first draft document was distributed.

- e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: Progress was made in the document architecture, defining a method to support more than eight devices, and in defining a dual port facility.

- f. Statement of Status as of This Report: Satisfactory progress has been made on this project, however it may encounter delays because of anticipated slips in the SCSI-3 Command Set project. Until the service interface between these documents is stable, it is not prudent to forward this standard.

- g. Future Plans: none.

- h. Reasons for Delay: This project has encountered delays due the slip in the SCSI-3 Parallel Interface project and may encounter further delays due to possible slips in the SCSI-3 Command Set project.

9. SCSI-3 Packetized Protocol (SPP)

- a. Project 881-D, SCSI-3 Packetized Protocol

- b. Target date for dpANS to X3:

- c. Project Description: The SCSI-3 Packetized Protocol standard will define a generic protocol for transferring SCSI-3 Command Set information in a packetized format. This will permit SCSI commands, data, and status to be transferred over serial interfaces in a highly portable fashion. This approach will minimize the amount of interface-specific information required to map to a given

interface. The SCSI-3 Packetized Protocol defines most of the functions it requires and uses minimal services of the specific interface. This protocol is intended to minimize "turn arounds" so that overhead times are minimally dependent on distance.

- d. Publications During Past Year: A first draft document and two counterproposals were distributed.
- e. Statement of Progress or Accomplishments During Year: Progress was made in defining the issues involved in a generic packet protocol. Two interface-specific proposals were received (Fibre Channel and P1394). It has become apparent that the generic approach is not optimal for all applications.
- f. Statement of Status as of This Report: In a recent meeting, it was proposed that several mapping documents (or sections in one document) be adopted as the document architecture. This would permit both generic and interface-specific mappings to be standardized. A small group is planning to meet to explore this approach further.
- g. Future Plans: Most likely, additional project proposals for specific mapping documents to Fibre Channel, P1394, and possibly other interfaces will be submitted during 1992.
- h. Reasons for Delay: No delay, yet.

e. Liaison Activities: X3T9.3, ISO/IEC JTC1/SC25/WG4, IT8.

f. Administrative Matters of Note:

As stated in my previous report, X3 should hire one or more professional editors and consider publishing X3 standards instead of using the ANSI publications department. This would ease the burden of finding qualified volunteer document editors in the Task Groups. The resulting standards would benefit from an earlier professional review and would likely be both higher in quality and more timely.

g. Procedural Matters of Note:

The first two comments are repeated from may last two reports. The third comment is new:

1. In most cases, it is not feasible to delay project development until approval of the project proposal.
2. It still takes too long to process documents through public review. Because these delays are so long, it is inevitable that changes will be made, guaranteeing a second public review. We should overlap the SPARC compliance review with the public review period.
3. The X3T9 Technical Committee is now so large both in terms of membership and projects that X3T9 and X3 should consider ways to improve its operation. The Technical Committee and its Task Groups (X3T9.2, X3T9.3, and X3T9.5) meet together for one week bi-monthly. It is difficult to squeeze any more meetings into these crowded weeks as even the evenings are used for meetings. Furthermore, two of the Task Groups regularly meet between plenary weeks for a week of working group meetings. The working group meeting weeks are almost as full as the plenary weeks. Any simplification of X3 rules and procedures would help this situation.

IV. Anticipated Projects

X3T9.2 has submitted project proposals for a Directly Addressable Device Interface and for Extensions to the AT Attachment Interface. Furthermore, X3T9.2 is considering recommending that two or more interface-specific mapping projects be initiated to map the SCSI-3 Command Set to serial interfaces. Depending on the results of further study, X3T9.2 may recommend that the SCSI-3 Command Set project be split into more than one project.

V. Future Trends in This Technical Area

The lower-level I/O interface market is in a state of transition. This is largely the result of technological advances that permit physically smaller disk drives. These drives will trend toward I/O interfaces that directly attach to host system circuit cards without an interface cable. This has resulted in less emphasis on interfaces employing a cable and more emphasis on interfaces that can either plug directly into a processor card or into a device connector such as the PCMCIA.

Meanwhile, other I/O interface applications such as magnetic tape, printers, and optical devices are trending toward serial interfaces to reduce cabling costs. A key enabling technology for these applications is the higher clock rates now available in CMOS and other circuit technologies.
