Subject: When to issue SDTR after WDTR

It not 100% clear in SCSI-2 that anytime a WDTR message is accepted that it must be followed immediately by a SDTR message.

I propose that in the SCSI-3 SIP document the following be added to make it clear that a SDTR message must follow a WDTR message that has not been rejected:

In the section which describes the WDTR message the following should be added:

- | If a synchronous data transfer agreement is in effect then:
 - |
 - | -If a WDTR message is rejected with a Message Reject message
 - | the prior synchronous data transfer agreement shall remain
 - | intact.
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 - | -If a WDTR message is not rejected with a Message Reject
 - | message a WDTR message shall reset the synchronous agreement
 - | to asynchronous mode.
