The Driskill is a world unto itself, a world, which transcends time and place. Located in the heart of Texas, this was once the proud show place of a cattle baron. Lovingly and luxuriously transformed into something far more enticing, the Driskill has become a private haven of opulence and comfort. Many movies including the most recent remake of the Alamo were shot at the hotel given the Driskill's look and historical significance. This grand hotel has been in existence, at this location since 1886, and looks a lot like it did in the late 1800's.

Directions:

From Bergstrom Airport: Exit the terminal and follow highway 71 West to IH35. Follow IH 35 North to the 6th-12th Streets exit. Exit and turn left on 6th Street. Travel five blocks to Brazos Street and turn right. The Driskill valet is immediately on your left.

From Dallas: Follow IH 35 South to the 8th-3rd Street exit, turn right on 6th Street. Follow 6th Street five blocks to Brazos Street. Turn right on Brazos. The Driskill valet is immediately on your left.

From San Antonio: Follow IH 35 North to 6th-12th Street exit, turn left on 6th Street. Follow 6th Street five blocks to Brazos Street. Turn right on Brazos. The Driskill valet is immediately on your left.

From Houston via highway 290: Follow Highway 290 West to IH 35. Follow IH 35 South to the 8th-3rd Street exit, and then turn right on 6th Street. Travel five blocks to Brazos Street. Turn right on Brazos. The Driskill valet is immediately on your left.

Attractions:

Located in the heart of central Texas, Austin stands as the gateway to the scenic Hill Country and the Highland Lakes. Located just a few hours from Dallas and Houston, the city of Austin is known as the live music capital of the country, and offers a culturally rich environment, with myriad galleries, restaurants, museums and theater. The largest concentration of music venues is found downtown in the Warehouse District and along Sixth Street, a six-block stretch of bars and restaurants.
