6 SRP Initiator Logout Proposal (01-205r0 by Cris Simpson)

This proposal lets the initiator tell the target it wants to logout with a new SRP_I_LOGOUT IU. It renames the existing logout IU to SRP_T_LOGOUT. The initiator logout has no tag and has no corresponding response IU.

Bob Snively recommended adding tables like FCP-2's table 4 and table 5 describing the effects of login/logout on various SCSI states (task sets, reservations, etc.) Cris will incorporate this into his proposal. This table will also cover target-originated logouts.

The group discussed "session" vs. "channel" terminology. Cris will send a definition of "session" to the T10 reflector and clarify that the logout only affects the session, not all the sessions forming the same nexus.

The target should logout immediately, not try to cleanly finish commands. The initiator must clean up outstanding tasks itself. "If it hurts, don't do it."

Cris will prepare r1 for next week.
