

T11, Fibre Channel Interfaces Liaison Report

August, 2006

- TC T11 last met August 10, 2006.
48 representatives of 42 organizations attended. The total number of member organizations is 50.
New projects FC-HBA, FC-FS-2/AM1, and FAIS-2 were announced.
FC-BB-3 and FC-AE-ASM were published.
T11 took all the requested actions of its TGs as described below.
- TG T11.2 - Fibre Channel Physical TG:
Membership is 39 organizations.
Projects in development include 10GFC Addendum, FC-MSQS, FCSM-2, FC-BaseT, FC-PI-3, and FC-PI-4. Key activities include

FC-BaseT, 8 Gb/s, modeling tools, and FC-PI-4.

Teleconferences were approved for FCSM-2, FC-BaseT, 8 Gb/s optical, 8 Gb/s electrical, and FC-PI-4.

Interim meetings were approved for FC-PI-4.

- T11.3 - FC logical / protocol TG

Membership is 36 organizations.

FC-FS-2 was forwarded for 2nd public review.

Projects in the development phase include:
FC-BaseT, FC-BB-4, FC-FS-2/Amd 1,
FC-GS-6, FC-IFR, FC-SATA, FC-SCM,
FC-SP-2, and FC-SW-5.

FC-LS and FC-AE-1553 comment resolution.

Teleconferences were authorized for
FC-FS-2 Amd 1, FC-LS, and FC-SATA.

- T11.5, storage network management TG
Membership is 25 organizations.
FAIS-2, SM-HBA-2, and SNPing are in development.
The FAIS project is in letter ballot resolution.
Teleconferences were authorized for FAIS.
- ISO Actions
Gary Robinson was recommended as WG-4 convener.
NWIPs were requested for a number of projects.
