7.1 SMC-3 Add PREVENT ALLOW MEDIA REMOVAL command (06-442r1)Noud Snelder

Noud explained his changes. The group seemed to agree with all the technical details, but had several editorial modifications to suggest.

Kevin Butt questioned the change of the text, “While a prevention of medium removal condition is in effect the media changer logical unit shall inhibit mechanisms that normally

allow removal of the medium by an operator.” and how the proposed text talks to the physical mechanisms that allow or prevent the removal. It removed all reference to “who” was allowed or prevented (i.e. application client vs. operator). Curtis Ballard agreed. A long discussion ensued.

Rod Wideman suggested that we might need to add an additional field to the PAMR command to handle the who. Kevin Butt suggested that we would need to also add a mode parameter to define the default behavior of who.

Discussion was called due to time.
