Noud questioned the use of the INFORMATION field as stated in section 6.1. The suggestion was to make the use of the INFORMATION field is a common way for SMC and have a mode clause for that usage.

Curtis has heard that several vendors would like to be able to use element disable on a slot that can be configured as an IE slot or as a storage slot so a configuration does not change. Rod told Curtis to write your own proposal.
