## **6. Old Business**

### **6.1 OSSC**

Embedded Disc format for OSSC is withdrawn due to inconsistency with several physical format specifications:

DVD+R and DVD+R DL do not permit any sequential recording (ECMA 349 §23.1.3) outside of the TOC specified recordings. The BD-R physical format specification has similar language.

The MMC proposal for OSSC has been adjusted accordingly.

There is concern about the VolumeZero not having a matching part at high addresses for proper recognition when UDF is used as the file system. By the rules, the Random Writable model should present an AVDP at LBA=256 and at LBA=N+256 where N is the maximum LBA on the media.

We refer to each different LBA space a "volume". Terminology overloading (e.g. Volume has a very different meaning w.r.t. UDF) may force a change or at least a better description..

Clarify and note in 4.4 that in T/S model LT# and S# are hidden and shifted, but LBAs are shifted only to make first session disappear.

### **6.2 ATAPI**

Curtis Stevens visited the meeting to announce that T13 will separate the PACKET feature from ATA-ACS, but T13 will maintain ownership and probably publish a separate document.
