7 Call for secretary [Suhler]

Paul Suhler noted that the ADC working group does not have a secretary at this time . He asked if anyone wished to volunteer to fill this role. No one volunteered, so Paul encouraged participants to consider taking up the role. Curtis Ballard agreed to serve as secretary for this teleconference.

8 Old business:

8.1 **ADC-3 Automation Device Serial Number subpage ([08-021r0](#)) [Wideman]**

Rod Wideman presented 08-021r0 to address an item from the ISV request for input in SSC.

Group discussed inclusion of removing the 'b' subscript from the target device serial number subpage as part of this proposal and agreed that change was appropriate and could be included in this proposal.

The group discussed the possibility of adding a VPD page for the ADC device server to report the serial number that has been set. The group determined that reading the serial number back via a mode page is sufficient and recommended that the VPD page be dropped.

Kevin Butt requested clarification for why we couldn't use the remote SMC logical unit serial number. Rod Wideman explained that it was because the remote SMC logical unit serial number is tied to bridging but this needs to work when bridging is not enabled.

Kevin Butt asked if the reference to SMC-2 was appropriate. Paul Suhler requested that we table the discussion and discuss references to other standards in March. Rod Wideman indicated that he though we attempted to reference approved standards unless required to reference draft standards.

Paul Suhler brought up the question of the variable length field in a mode page. Curtis Ballard responded that he felt mode pages needed to be fixed length and referenced SCP4r12 section 6.9 which states that a mode select length shall match the length of the mode sense.

The group recommended changing to a fixed length field with a right aligned serial number referencing right aligned verbiage in SPC. The length of the field was discussed with IBM requesting at least 16 and HP requesting at least 20. The group recommended 32 characters.

There was a discussion of whether a field was needed to describe the length of the serial number but with a right aligned value the group determined that was not necessary.

Kevin Butt indicated that rather than having a fixed length field it could be required to be a fixed length but with the actual length not set by the standards.

Rod Wideman asked if we could state that a mode sense before a mode select shall be rejected. Several group members responded that their models always used mode sense first and expect it to succeed.

Rod Wideman asked whether attempting to set this via a mode page was not the correct model and we should consider a different vehicle. Working group recommended a new command which would require a method to read back the value that had been set. Working group guidance was for a matching SET/REPORT command.

Working group recommended a general purpose command modeled off of set medium attribute with only the automation device serial number defined.

8.2 ADT-2: SCSI Command IU to Initiator only port ([07-438r0](#)) [Suhler]

A question was raised on what should be done for error recovery. Paul indicated he would research that offline and update the proposal for March.

Working group determined that a recoverable error detected message should be sent which puts the device into the receiver error recovery state matching.

Paul Suhler will continue work on revising this document. Action item 07-060 already exists so no new action item was given.

8.3 ADT-2: ADT over Ethernet (ADToE) ([07-469r0](#)) [Suhler]
