Dear Jeff,

It has come to my attention that Western Digital Corp. is distributing a document that falsely claims to be a "draft proposed American National Standard of Accredited Standards Committee X3". The cover page on the document also mimics the style and format of an actual draft proposed American National Standard.

I understand the document contains a proposal to extend the AT Attachment interface to support CD-ROM devices. This may be a worthwhile endeavor, but the proper procedure is to submit such a proposal, clearly identified as a company or individual proposal, to the appropriate X3 subgroup; in this case, X3T9.2.

By distributing this document with a cover page containing false and misleading information, I am concerned people not closely involved with the X3 standards development process would incorrectly conclude that the document is indeed a nearly completed standards project within X3. This could lead to bad business decisions and possible litigation.

To correct any misconceptions and to protect Western Digital, I am requesting that Western Digital correct the false and misleading statements on the cover of this document and distribute a letter to the organizations that received the misidentified document explaining the actual status of the document. That is, it has not been proposed or submitted to X3 and is not a draft proposed American National Standard.

Since you are the Principal member of X3T9.2 from Western Digital, I have addressed this letter to you. I realize that you may not have anything to do with this document, but I trust you will be able to forward this letter to the appropriate person or persons within Western Digital. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
